Since May, the Buddy-Teams of the program already got their first experiences. Now, the program prepares for the next round, the school year 2016-2017.

All interested colleagues with and without migration history are invited to the meeting on the 19th September to talk and exchange about the experiences in the teams so far and about how to go on. Also, there will be the possibility to form more new Buddy-Teams!
